

## KINLET PARISH COUNCIL

The March meeting was held on the 9<sup>th</sup> of the month when eight members were present.

There were still some highway matters needing attention with the most urgent being the pothole repairs on the B.4194. Despite exhaustive representations to numerous highway officers – including the leader of the Council and our M.P. Stuart Anderson, no date for these repairs had been advised but with assurances that this work was in the system. A most unsatisfactory state of affairs.

The following planning applications were discussed. 1.26/00682/CPE re application for a Lawful Development Certificate for the existing use of land as residential garden at Forest View, Button Oak was for information only. 2. 26/00681/PIP for permission in principle for a single dwelling east of Forest View, Button Oak. Unanimous decision to recommend approval after proposal and seconding 3. 26/00706/FUL for proposed two storey extension to incorporate lift and first floor extension at Tanglewood, Button Oak. Also recommended for approval unanimously after proposal and seconding. (Mr Crawford took no part in the discussion or voting) Planning Permissions had been notified for 26/00076/FUL re erection of 3 bay open fronted garage at Tawny House, Button Bridge Lane and 25/04754/FUL for loft conversion with pitched dormers and erection of detached single storey garage at Forest Rise, Dowles Road. Also 25/04617/FUL for retrospective erection of a new stable block at Glen Cottage, 12 Button Bridge Lane.

It was agreed to make the following annual donations – Kinlet Playgroup - £150.00/Severn Hospice - £200.00 – shared Hospice and At Home care/Midlands Air Ambulance - £300.00 / S.A.R.A. £100.00/ Highly First Responder - £100.00/Kinlet School (cheque to S.C.) - £150.00.

The Bank Reconciliation for 1/10/2025 to 31/12/2025 was unanimously approved and the Internal Auditor re-elected, although this had to be a person independent of the Parish Council despite the name.

Members of the Council had joined a meeting with a West Mercia Community Support Officer for a general discussion and a litter pick was arranged for March 29<sup>th</sup>. The Leader of Shropshire Council, together with a representative, from Highways would attend our Annual Parish meeting on the 11<sup>th</sup> May.

The date of the next meeting was arranged for Monday 13<sup>th</sup> April 2026 in the Village Hall commencing at 7.30 pm with public participation and the meeting closed at approximately 8.40 p.m.
